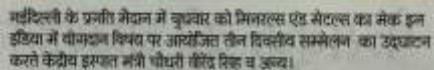

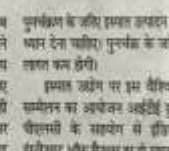

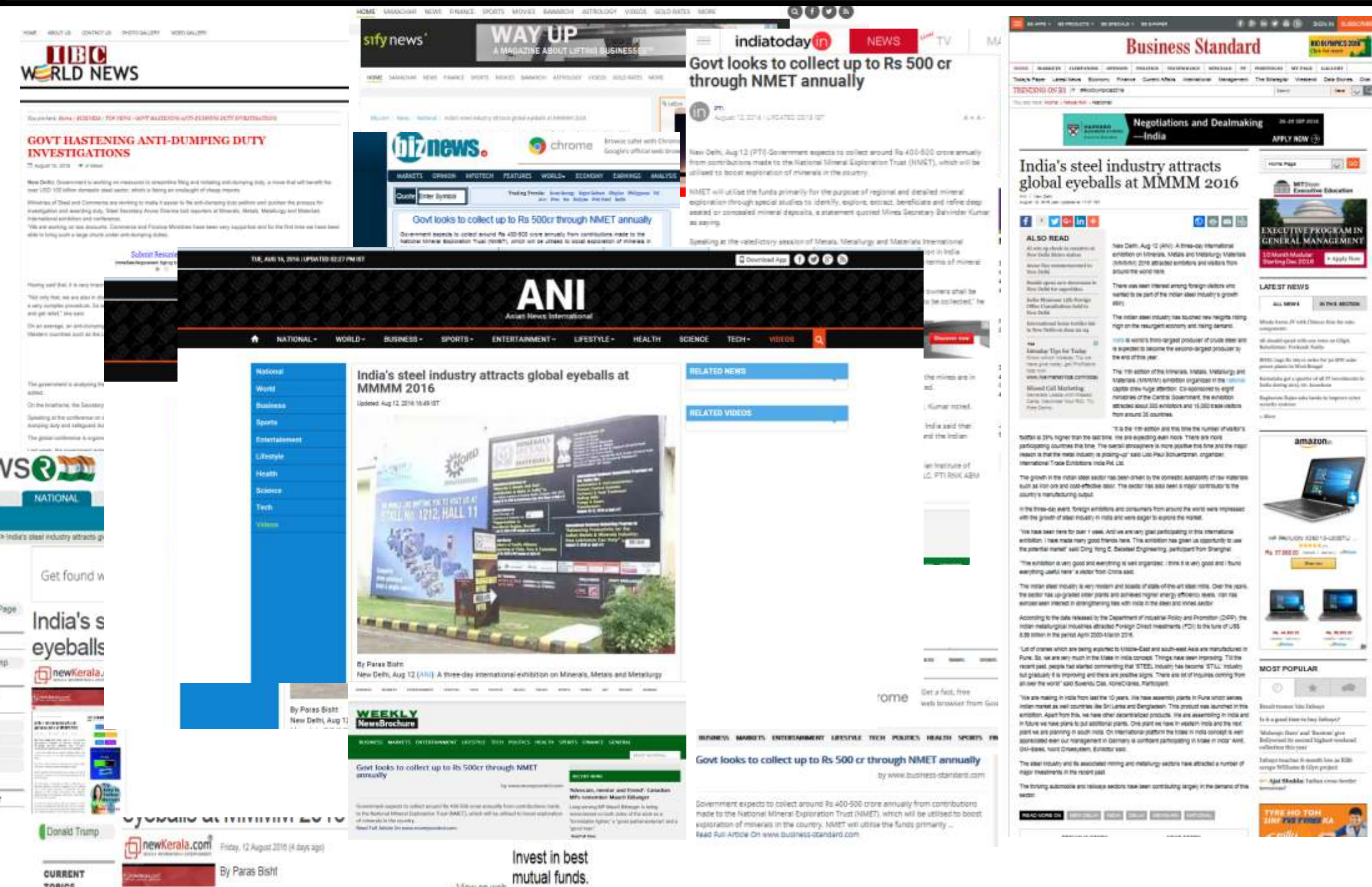

Govt hastening anti-dumping duty investigations

New Delhi: Government is seeking on measures to streamline filing and initiating anti-dumping duty, a move that will benefit the over USD 108 billion domestic steel sector, which is facing an onslaught of cheap imports.

Ministers of Steel and Commerce are seeking to make a move in the anti-dumping duty pattern and expedite the process for investigation and assessing duty. Steel Secretary Anura Sharma told *Business Today* at Minister's Meeting, Metals International exhibition and conference here.

He is meeting on two accounts. Commerce and Finance Ministers have been very supportive and for the first time we have been able to bring such a large group under anti-dumping duties. Having said that, it is very important to do the homework, well and bring at least an order anti-dumping duty.

"Not only that, we are also in discussions with Commerce Ministry to speed up on the procedure for checking anti-dumping duty. It is a very complex procedure. So what the Government has decided is to do this homework and get relief," she said.

As an example, on anti-dumping duty procedure from filing petition to assessing of duty takes between 3-6 months, unlike in some Western countries such as the US and the European Union, it takes around two to two-and-a-half months.

The government is analysing the models, across the globe and the faster is go and set policy earlier, the better it will be for steel sector. Sharma added.

In the meanwhile, the Secretary said, "We have to do this in two or three months. That's not a small target".

Speaking at the conference an important message to the steel industry, she said the better way to go about it through anti-dumping-duty and safeguard duty. Sharma urged every I&D in the steel sector to get involved. [Click here to read more](#)

The global conference is organized by Indian Institute of Metals in association with ITE, OGC, PLG, among many others.

Last week, the government extended the IIP on steel products by two months, but promised the full from 123 products to 65. It said the rest of the products will be brought under anti-dumping duty, which is a tariff-based measure.

While inaugurating the conference, Steel Minister Chaudhary Bhanu Singh said government is taking measures to support the industry against cheap imports, adding that the sector should also concentrate on optimum utilization of inputs, minerals and processing to become more competitive.

"We need to move ourselves on REC as it is a crucial part for us to compete for the competition abroad. But just that it will not help us produce better products at competitive cost," he added.

Sharma said the industry will grow, grow ahead as the government has put its efforts at infrastructure development.


Encouraging industry to increase production after gradually losing, Sharma said, "We need to also look at exporting to seek costs. 3-40 MT steel is produced through recycling, it will help save at least as five to ten per cent."

70-80 MINERAL BLOCKS LIKELY TO GO ON AUCTION BY END OF 2016

KOLKATA: Some 70-80 mineral blocks are likely to be put on auction by the end of the year, while seven blocks have been allocated through auction and tenders have been issued for another 35, union mines secretary Balvinder Kumar has said. "Our mineral production contributes 2.5% to the GDP and in value terms it amounts to Rs 27 lakh crore. While mineral production in India registered 9% growth in 2015-16, we are inching towards a stage wherein we have surplus coal production and shall be able to export it soon," the mine secretary said while speaking at Minerals, Metals, Metallurgy & Materials International Exhibition and Conference (MMMM 2016). Highlighting the District Mineral Foundation (DMF) as another big initiative, the mines secretary said 30% of royalty collected from mine owners shall be spent on socio-economic development of the mine areas and affected population. An amount of Rs 6000 crore would be put in the DMFs. The official also said an amount of Rs 400-500 crore is expected to be collected as 2% royalty from mine owners, which shall be dedicated for exploration as part of National Mineral Exploration Trust (NMET). "We are starting the Aero Geophysical Survey wherein out of the 34 lakh sq. km. area, 8 lakh sq. km. of Obvious Geo Potential Area or OGP Area wherein evidence of mineral deposits are available, shall be surveyed in two years of time. A global agency shall be appointed for it. By March 2017, we aim to survey 2.5 lakh sq. km. of the OGP Area. This data shall be accessible by the public," he added. The ministry is also taking effective steps for checking illegal mining and it shall use space technology for it. Digitized maps of mineral leases shall be put under satellite monitoring and mining other than these areas shall be tracked by the Indian Bureau of Mines. A special control room is being set up in Hyderabad for it," the mines secretary added. The minister of state for steel, Vishnu Deo Sai addressed the valedictory session of 11th edition of MMMM 2016.

"Not to forget the steel for strategic sector - defence production, including naval warships, frigates, nuclear reactors and SRD's space vehicles, India seems to be importing almost all this special requirement as of now," he added.
